KRKGDC CELEBRATES TELUGU LANGUAGE DAY, HONORS GIDUGU RAMAMURTHY PANTULU

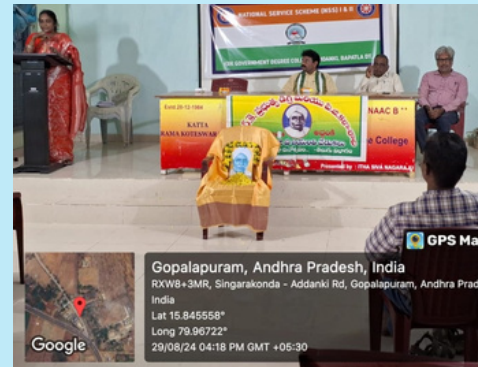
