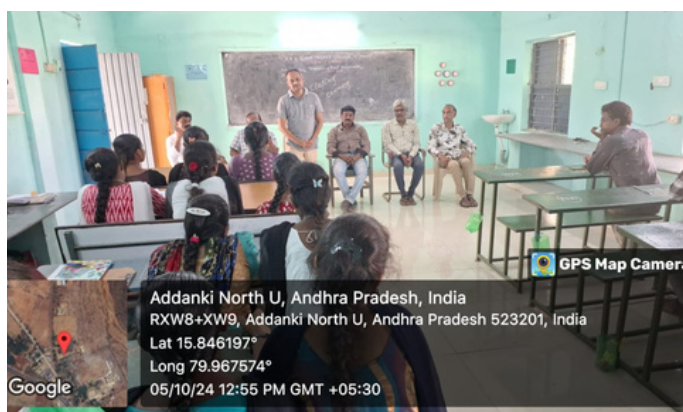
Certificate Distribution Ceremony Concludes Successful Course on "Vegetable and Fruit Preservation" at KRKGDC, Addankig

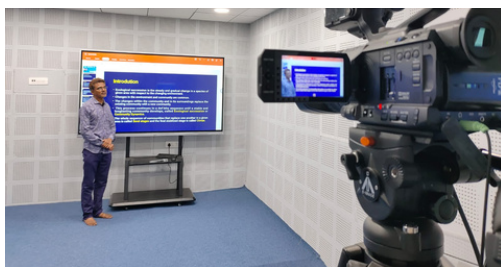
