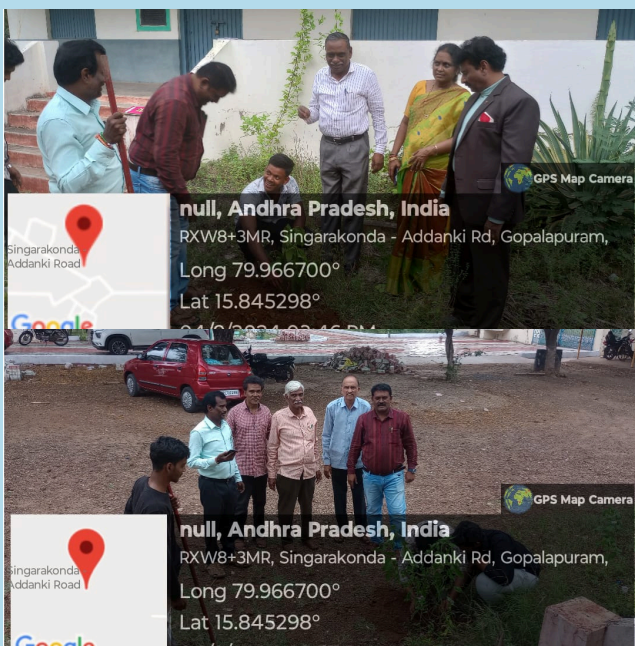
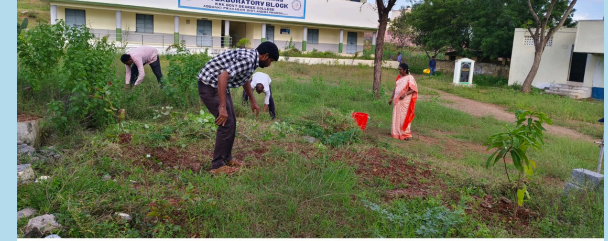
Looking Ahead
